I declare that:

- d) Article 5I of Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014⁷, which would result in a prohibition of providing direct or indirect support, including financing and financial assistance or any other advantage under a national programme;
- 2) the support provided to the Applicant by the following Consortium members: Łukasiewicz Research Network Poznań Institute of Technology, Institute of Bioorganic Chemistry of the Polish Academy of Sciences, Poznań Supercomputing and Networking Center or Wielkopolska Agricultural Advisory Center will not be allocated:
 - a) for activities prohibited under EU legal acts adopted or amended in connection with Russia's aggression against Ukraine, i.e. Council regulations: 2022/2638, (UE) nr 833/2014, (UE) nr 692/20149 or (WE) nr 765/200610, Council Decision: (CFSP) 2022/26611, 2014/512/CFSP12, 2014/145/CFSP or 012/642/CFSP13];
 - b) to satisfy the claims referred to in Art. 11 of Council Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014, in Art. 11 Council Regulations (EU) No. 269/2014, (EU) No. 208/2014, Art. 10 of Council Regulation (EU) 2022/263, art. 6 of Council Regulation (EU) No. 692/2014, Art. 8d of Council Regulation (EC) No. 765/2006, art. 7 of Council Decision 2014/512/CFSP or Art. 2n of Council Decision 2012/642/CFSP
